Abstract

"Past and present in one frame. Analysis of the process of creating a short animated film entitled "Three Cups of Coffee." The work begins with a citation of selected theoretical concepts on time in film, with particular emphasis on theories showing how time in film can flow in two ways, coexisting with memory and subjective experience. The next chapter analyzes selected films that implement these theories and served as inspiration and references for the author in her work on the short film.
